


Today i.e. 02/09/2023 at 8.30 am, while reading the local Newspapers "The Sangai Express" (English edition) and "Poknapham", it is found that one of the member of Committee on Mass Protest against Assam Rifles Smt. Sharmila Naosekpam in presence of many State's Women folk Meira Paibi leaders decried neither the State Government nor the Central Government pay due attention to the present violent crisis since the day i.e. 3rd May, 2023 and demanding to held an Assembly Session in order to discuss the burning topic/issue and adopt a resolution to protect Manipur. As both the Central Government and State Government have shown little respect to the people's voice, so citizens need not to obey the Government, she asserted. Hence, the Committee has decided and launches a people's disobedience movement from 1st September, 2023. As a part of the disobedience movement, the committee warned all the Central and State employees not to attend their office and if any employee is found attending office in defiance of the people's call, the employee should be held accountable for any untoward incident resulting thereof. Sharmila further declared that movement of Central force and Government vehicles would be forbidden. She also asserted that as the Central and State Government does not follow the law of the land, the people will not follow the law of the land, she also warned with dire consequences to the relief camp organizers not to accept any relief materials or gift from the Army or paramilitary forces.

The committee held an unlawful assembly on 01/09/2023 in the afternoon at Uripok Khoisnam Leikai further declaring their points of disobedience as resisting or obstructing the lawful apprehension of another person, causing wrongful restraint to the public, criminal force to deter public servant from discharging their duties with criminal intimidation and intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace under a criminal conspiracy with other unknown leaders and groups.

Hence, a suo-motu case under FIR No. 734(9)2023 IPS w/s 149/188/225/341/353/504/506/120-B IPC has been registered against Smt. Sharmila Naosekpam and other members of Committee On Mass Protest against Assam Rifle for investigation.
