On 3/5/2023 after having dinner, my son Pakrangil told us that it was becoming dangerous for us to remain in our village as Kuki militants have started threatening our villagers. We took shelter at Jaingang- pokpi for the night and went back to our house on 4/5/2023. However, the situation escalated and we fled to Khurai. Angom Leima, being for our lives and stayed there for some 4 days ago.
