LODGING OF FIR AGAINST 'MEIRA PAIBIS'

- On the morning of 12 October 2023, at around 0830 hrs continuous exchange of fire took place between Sabungkhok Khunou and Twichin village by the miscreants (thereinafter 'villages'). Accordingly SF Columns were launched to control the situation.
- At approx 0830 hrs, the said columns moved to Yaingangpokpi, where a riotous 2. mob comprising of aggressively agitating ladies identifying themselves as 'Meira Paibis' had already blocked all the entry and exit routes to the village, and allowed no Army Column to move thereby wrongfully restraining and confining the personnel. However, the Meira Paibis allowed ASP Herojit to pass along with his five teams of Police commandos.
- Security Forces also tried to enter through Sabungkhok Khunao village but, again 3. they were stopped by the Meira Paibis, and did not allow Security Forces from carrying out their bonafide military duty. Simultaneously, the police was requested by the army to forthwith send Rapid Action Force to take control of the rioters and apprehend the rioters as per set legal procedure.
- The Indian Army along with police requested the Meira Paibis not to obstruct the Army personnels from carrying out their bonafide military duty. However, they refused to do so and tried to assault and cause hurt to army personnel's including attempt to snatch the personal weapons of the Army personnel.
- Furthermore, the riotous situation was created by the Meira Paibis to facilitate the 5. escape of armed miscreants from lawful custody with intent of causing disappearance of evidence and screening of suspected miscreants accused of serious offences including causing grievous injuries to local populace. The Meira Paibis surrounded the Security Forces physically, assaulted them and tried to snatch their weapons during which three soldiers suffered minor injuries.
- All the photographic evidence of the incident spot are enclosed along with the 6. certificate under section 65B of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872. The said rioters may immediately be identified and arrested to prevent them from giving effect to their criminal This report is treated as an et of care FIR no 366/1029120/147/148/149/201/224/225/332/353 504/505/506/34 IPC & 25/1-c/A Act. intent and conspiracy.
