With due regards, I am writing to report a theft case that occurred inside the school Sir, premises in the early hours of 14th October 2023. As per the available CCTV footage, the incident involved two individuals who appeared to be in their twenties.

Water Taps numbering about 60 installed in the Girls Toilet complex, Hostel Complex and staff Toilet complex were stolen. Two Wash basins and a water pump were also damaged. The stolen water taps and the damaged items are collectively valued at approximately Rs. 60,000/-. Almost all the connecting pipes from flush to tap were stolen rendering all the toilet complexes in the school almost defunct.

In this regard, I am to request you to conduct a thorough investigation into this matter and appropriate action be taken against the individuals responsible for this theft at the earliest.
