

That the store "Bazar India" was closed on 04.05.2023 due to heavy and uncontrolled protests in the area, however the unidentified rioters targeted the store of the complainant and broke open the locks of the store. Rioters first looted the store and then torched Bazaar India on fire.

The act of loot and arson has caused a huge financial loss to the complainant. The unsold stock and fixtures installed by complainant at Bazar India amounting to Rs. 2,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crores) approx have been looted and lost due to arson.

That the said criminal acts committed by unidentified accused has resulted into loss of property to the complainant which is punishable u/s 120B, 149, 379 and 435 of the Indian Penal Code. Kindly investigate the matter and punish the unidentified accused/rioters for loot and arson.
