With due respect, I am to state that we have somehow narrowly escaped with my family members being physically attack with deathly weapon on the night of 3rd May, 2023 by mob without any provocation and without any warning. As such, we immediately run for our lives leaving behind our personal belong as mentioned below since we have no other alternative left with us. We request you to kindly take appropriate necessary to punish the culprits and take action for recovery of lost cash and properties.
