I have the honour to state that, on the 4th May, 2023 at around 8:00 AM some unknown miscreants belonging to Meitei individuals stormed and enter a campus of my residence in New Checkon, Imphal. In the process these individuals vandalized my properties and looted all my valuables items. The approximate value of the destroyed and lost properties are estimated to be about 36,59,494 lacs.
