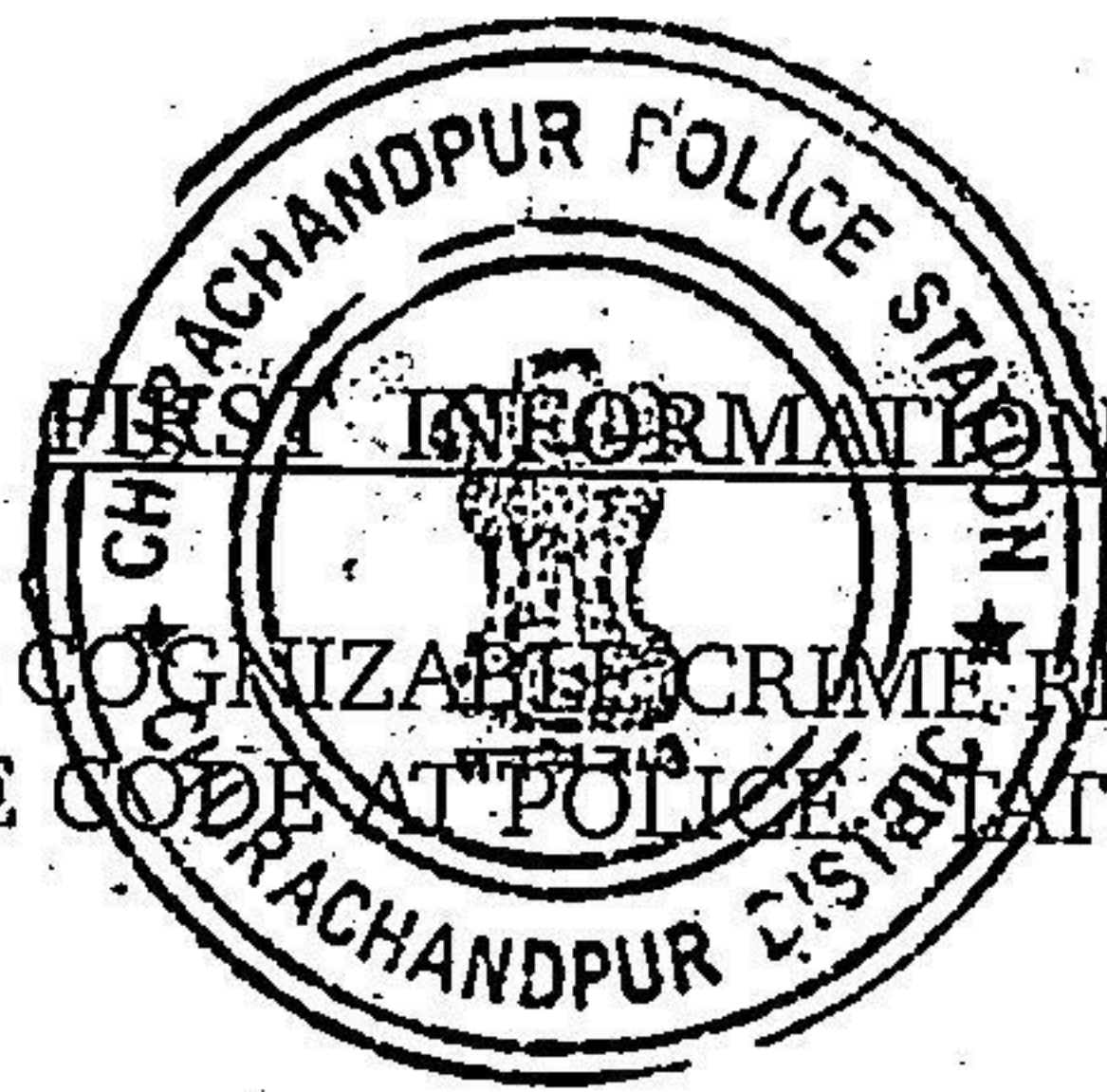

Subject: - Registration of FIR with respect to attempt to murder and causing grievous injuries.

Sir/Madam,

This is to bring to your kind notice that I, Ms. Ching Lun Niang, local resident of Simveng, Churachandpur District, Manipur and belonging to the Kuki-Zo Community have suffered immensely due to the riots and outbreak of violence in Manipur on 3rd May, 2023. I have taken refuge in Munirka Village, New Delhi along with my sister, Ms. Bonny Hat Khan Hoih d/o Khamchinmang born on 21st April, 1994 for her treatment and to safeguard ourselves from the continued threats of the majority Meitei Community. The Meitei Community have caused the rampant violence and burning/vandalizing the houses and properties belonging to the Kuki-Zo people who residents in the Imphal Valley and other districts as well.

On 5th May 2023, in Lamka town, I and my sister Bonny along with few women of our community were stationed near Venus Hotel, while at a distance of 20m from us, few vehicles had been parked. The said vehicles were not visible as the streetlights had been destroyed as a result of the violence. We mistook the vehicles to be that of the Army and stood close by for safety and security. However, suddenly, they started firing directly at us and as a result two women and another man died on the spot. We thought it was blank fire shots until my sister got shot in the abdomen, and started bleeding. Around 27-28 people were injured in the open fire. We all panicked and started running in every direction. There were no police officials or Central Security officers to be found and to protect us. An ambulance which later arrived to help the injured, was also shot at by the assailants.

On the same night of 5th May, 2023, my sister was admitted in the District Hospital, Churachandpur which was majorly dependent on valley (Meitei) doctors. Due to the ongoing violence the frequency of doctor visits was minimal. Eventually on 8th May, my sister was airlifted to Health City Hospital Guwahati along with two other men for treatment.

We incurred medical expenses in District Hospital Churachandpur, Guwahati, AIIMS along with other expenses of accommodation, food, travel etc amounting to Rupees Nine Lakhs Sixty Thousand (₹ 9,60,000/-).

We were discharged from the Health City Hospital Guwahati on 22nd May, 2023. My sister was then referred to the Trauma Ward of AIIMS Delhi. We were able to arrange the expenses somehow through philanthropic volunteers and reached Delhi on 3rd June 2023 and my sister was admitted in AIIMS on the same day.

All the expenses that we incurred were mostly made by Student Organizations through calls for donations, and the Zomi Welfare Association. These chains of incidents and events have traumatized me and my family very much. We continue to live in New Delhi without any source of income and till date have not received any relief from the Government of Manipur or the Central Government.

I humbly request that appropriate actions be taken against the miscreants by the law of our nation and justice be meted out to me.
