


FIR AGAINST COCOMI FOR WRITING THE ARTICLE
"STOP THE PARTISAN CONDUCT COCOMI ADVICES"

Sir,

1. Please refer Article published in The Sangai Express newspaper "**Stop the Partisan conduct COCOMI Advices**" on 13 Jul 2023 (Copy attached) alleging Assam Rifles to be ineffective in guarding the porous borders, smuggling drugs, not detecting illegal immigrants and siding with Kuki militants.
2. The above mentioned articles purports to give out unverified and false information aimed at maligning the Assam Rifles, other military organization and the Government. The contents of the said articles are factually incorrect and defamatory. The statements used in the article are clearly aimed at spreading disaffection, are prejudicial to national integration and also prime facie violative of Sec 153 A of the IPC.
3. The contents of the article are malicious and the same also amount to bring hatred/excite disaffection towards the agency of the Government in contravention to Section 124A of the IPC. The same are also likely to promote enmity between the communities, are prejudicial to maintenance of harmony between communities and are likely to disturb public tranquility and thus, violative of Section 153A of the IPC.
4. The publication of the article has been done with ulterior motives to defame the Assam Rifles and HQ IGAR (S) and thus, amounts to violation of Section 499 and 500 of the IPC. The above publication is also detrimental to peace and harmony in the state as it is likely to cause hindrance for the Assam Rifles personnel to discharge their duty, in contravention to Section 505 of the IPC.
5. Thus, it is required that an investigation in accordance with law into the same be carried out and strict action be taken against "COCOMI" for the defamatory article for inciting hatred against a Government Agency, provoking violence amongst masses and instigating people.

Stop the partisan conduct, COCOMI advises

IMPHAL, Jul 13 The Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity

(COCOMI) has warned that

all the atrocities committed by Assam Rifles would be revealed before the whole world if the paramilitary force does not stop supporting narco-terrorists.

Questioning what compelled the withdrawal of Assam Rifles from Kangla in 2004, a statement issued by COCOMI said that there are numerous incidents of atrocities committed by AR troops upon the people of Manipur.

There were also many noble and commendable deeds of AR. However, the integrity and reputation have been let down by some batallions/companies. This must be known to the IGO AR (South), it asserted.

Although it is said that the AR troops are here to help the State Government maintain law and order, they are acting as if they are above the State Government and they have been meddling with the affairs of the State.

As a result, people's abhorrence and anger against Assam Rifles have gone to the extreme.

After it was confirmed that some Kukis from Myanmar who sustained bullet and splinter injuries were treated at Churachandpur district hos-

pital in the midst of the gun battles fought between narco-terrorists and Manipur Police, Assam Rifles said that they intercepted the Myanmar at the border and 10 Myanmar were given passage to India due to medical emergency, and the same was reported in the Hindu.

The AR troops, like other security forces, must protect the bonafide citizens of the country. However, they have been maintaining a close bond with the narco-terrorists, the COCOMI said.

It then asked whether the AR troops have any authority to allow entry of Myanmar Nationals into India (Manipur) without the knowledge of the Government of Manipur.

Further questioning if the AR troops are entrusted with a secret agenda by the Government of India to promote narco-terrorists, the COCOMI pointed out that the free movement regime of up to 16 Kms that existed between Myanmar and India was abolished by the State Government some time back.

The people of Manipur strongly condemn the way the AR has been supporting a particular side in the ongoing conflict.

Rebutals and clarifications issued by Assam Rifles

which looked like supporting Myanmar Kukis, and the way they have been acting like a political party or a Government is an insult to the State Government and the rule of law, it alleged.

Since the very beginning of the crisis, Kuki militants were directly involved but the AR was acting ignorant. It was right under the nose of AR troops that many Maitoi people were killed and a large number of their houses were burnt down in Churachandpur, Moreh and Kangpokpi on May 3, it said.

Again, when several Maitoi houses were burnt down by Kuki militants including Myanmar Kukis at Serou, AR troops acted as mute spectators.

However, when the villagers and State forces retaliated, AR troops came out of their camp and tried to save the narco-terrorists which included CDF militants, it said.

People saw very vividly how Kuki militants including Myanmar Kukis ran into Assam Rifles camp when civilians retaliated to their offensive, it continued.

Transporting a huge quantity of arms and ammunition by Assam Rifles to Churachandpur a few days back in the name of arrival of additional personnel was highly suspicious because

weapons are always issued to AR personnel when they are sent on duty.

People cannot help but suspect the presence of narco-terrorists in the midst of AR troops. AR troops' failure to react in time when narco-terrorists attacked commando personnel at Nepali Basti Moreh right in front of their eyes bred strong resentment among the people, it said.

Moreover, much before the current crisis erupted, there were several instances of attacking police personnel at Moreh, police pickets were burnt down and shots were fired at the gate of police station but Assam Rifles posted at the border did not take up a single tangible action against these criminal and unlawful activities.

There were also several instances of AR troops taking away Kuki militants after they were arrested by Moreh police. Further,

there were many drug seizure cases where AR personnel were involved.

For all these reasons, the people have a strong suspicion that the Assam Rifles has a nexus with the Kuki narco-terrorists, it said.

The COCOMI then urged the Government of India and the State Government to withdraw all Assam Rifles troops from Manipur.

District (for UKLF) with full knowledge of the Assam Rifles. While KNA set up its camp at Moreh Ward No.1, the camp of UKLF is at Moreh is at S. Moloi Village opposite to Chavangphai Assam Rifles Camp, Moreh. Both the SoO bound outfits are freely moving in and around the Moreh with arms, extorting money from businessman and public as well as indulging in kidnapping and demanding ransom very frequently. At Haolenphai Village, around 3 Km from Moreh town, around 70 armed cadres of the People's Democratic Front (PDF), Myanmar, a foreign non-SoO signatory militant 2 outfit is stationed with the full knowledge of Assam Rifles. KNA is training the PDF cadres at Sahei Village and B. Bongjang Village with full knowledge of the Assam Rifles. Furthermore, the Assam Rifles has created the conducive environment to seep in Kuki migrants from Myanmar and allow illegal poppy cultivation in encroached areas. While Kuki frontal organisation like the Kuki Students' Organisation physically transports the illegal Kuki migrants from Myanmar, their Aadhar and other related identity documents are prepared by Autonomous District Council at the Behest of Hills Tribal Council, Moreh. It is more or less the same phenomena in other Kuki dominated districts of Manipur where different Kuki frontal organisations undertake the task. Furthermore, through narco-trade, Kuki militants are able to buy sophisticated weapons and arm the Kuki civilians and illegal migrants. Assam Rifles play a key role even in this arms-trade.

Since, May 3rd 2023, reports have been pouring in that the Assam Rifles are mute spectators when Kuki militants torched Meitei houses, prevent Manipuri volunteers to ward off Kuki militants. For example, the burning down of the houses in Serou and is done by the armed cadres of UKLF stationed at the non-designated camp of Nazareth Village established by the Assam Rifles at Khambathel around 1/2 km from Sugnu Bazar. The burning down of the whole village of Tangjeng Wangma Ahallup under Kumbi AC was also carried out by The Armed Kuki militants coming in two Boleros that passed through various Assam Rifle posts. This is the same story in Gwalatabi, Sanasabi, Awang Sekmai, Dolaithabi, Sabungkhok Khnonou. Torching of the Meitei houses by Kuki militants occurred right under the nose of the Assam Rifles. There has not been a single instance in which the Assam Rifles stopped the drug-boosted armed Kuki civilians, migrants and militants in their rampaging acts of torching Meitei houses and assaulting the helpless Meitei civilians right in front of their eyes. Once again, the Assam Rifles has the full knowledge.

Now the question is: Why do the Assam Rifles allow this method madness to continue? In other words, why is India in its attempt to finish off valley-based insurgents allowing Kuki militants to target the Meitei civilians? The answer is simple. As stated above it is to finish insurgency in Manipur. Nevertheless, this is an unethical Indian military policy once its mercenary starts targeting the civil population. This military hardware can be corrupted anytime and malfunction harming India's national security in the long run. For the moment, India must be responsible for its attempt of turning this narco-terrorism into a communal or people-people clash. And we Manipuris must not fall into the rickety trap. To conclude, what is happening is not a Kuki versus Meitei clash. It is deeper design of the Indian military establishment and its oiled monster hardware matrix fulfilling the task.
