Sir, With due respect, I would like to state that as per SP, CCPur order No. B-12/13(L&O)/SP-CCP/2018/2418 dated 04/06/2023 and CO, 1st IRB authorisation for movement dated 05/08/2023, I, the undersigned, alongwith my team from BN. HQ., 1st IRB was deployed as Reinforcement Team to assist the Gothol post whilst heavy exchange of fire with armed miscreants suspected to be valley based UGs at Gothol-Pholjang Village and its adjoining area. We stayed in the post from 05/08/2023 till 07/08/2023.

On 06/08/2023, the duty personnel encountered heavy firing from the armed miscreants again from the North-eastern border side of Gothol Village from early in the morning at around 07:00 AM which lasted throughout the day. 1st IRB Personnel of Gothol post who were on stand/duty together with BSF Personnel and District Police personnel faced heavy Shelling from the armed miscreants. Duty personnel also exchange the shot of fire from the armed miscreants and also use MORTAR Shell intermittently to intimidate the miscreants and stop their attack. Exchange of fire took place till around 06:00 PM. The following ammunitions & MORTAR Shells are fired out at around 10:00 AM and 06:00 PM of 06/08/2023:
