With due respect, I am to state that we have somehow narrowly escaped with my family members being physically attack with deathly weapon on the night of 3rd May, 2023 by mob without any provocation and without any warning. As such, we immediately run for our lives leaving behind our Recording studio as mentioned below. We request you to kindly take appropriate necessary action and arrange for recovery of lost properties.
