It has openly lowered the majesty the Hon'ble House and at the same time it has also maligned our hard-earned public perception as MLAs in the eyes of the general public during this sensitive hour of the State of Manipur. It further amounts to provoking and promoting enmity in the Society which is against the interest of our mother land. We have indeed suffered irreparable loss of reputation and public image by such a reckless and irresponsible statement of the accused because we have no connection whatsoever or involvement with any poppy plantations or narcotic drugs and we are only committed to fight against drug menace by supporting the War on Drugs 2.0 of the present State Government led by BJP for the sake of our future generation.

The complainants came to know about such statement of the said accused in the social media i.e., Facebook on 5th July, 2023 within jurisdiction of this Police Station.

In the above fact and circumstances, it is requested for taking up necessary legal action including registration of FIR against the above-mentioned culprit to punish her in accordance with the law.
