Sir,

with due respect, I have the honour to state that on the 3rd May 2023 at around 7:00 PM, Volunteers of Meitei world Council, Arambai Tenggal, Kangleipak Kanba Lup, Meitei Leepun numbering around 3000 attacked and burnt down my private residence at Nongmaipal Village, Imphal East. They also looted my household properties including livestock - 8 buffaloes and 9 Goats. They also burnt down my 2wheeler Royal Enfield Bullet bearing registration number TN04AX2343 my original document (10th, 12th Marksheet, BA Marksheet, Voter ID card) and land Patta (Zamabandi) and cash worth 1,00,000 (one lakh). The estimate Value of my looted and burnt down property is worth around 40 lakhs.

Therefore I request your good office to kindly take up necessary action in this regard.
