However, during the treacherous 15-kilometer stretch from Koirengai to Gangiphai and Motbung, the army valiantly fought for our lives for a harrowing four hours. They eventually ensured our safe arrival at our relatives' residence in Motbung. Later we decide to leave Manipur in search of safer place and on 23<sup>rd</sup> we came to Guwahati. Subsequent to our departure, our concerned neighbors informed us that miscreant groups had burgled and vandalized our house. Regrettably, we have suffered significant losses, including the following items:

**Subject: Complaint regarding destruction and damage of property**

Respected sir,

I am writing to file a formal police complaint regarding the alarming communal pogrom that unfolded in our state, Manipur, commencing from May 3, 2023. My name is S. Otkhosat Ashaat Haokip, residing at Palace Compound, Plot No. 5, near Castle Hotel, Wangkhei, Imphal East - 795005. I urgently seek your attention, intervention, and immediate action in addressing the following serious matters:

On May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023, I was made aware of distressing reports from numerous relatives and friends regarding the outbreak of mass violence in Churachandpur, Imphal, and various other regions of Manipur. I want to bring to your notice a specific incident that occurred on May 4<sup>th</sup> 2023 at our rented place in Palace Compound. A mob of approximately 50-60 individuals from the Meetei community armed with stones and bamboo rods entered our compound. They proceeded to demand the presentation of our Aadhaar cards, with the intention of identifying Kuki tribals. Our Aadhaar cards were confiscated by the mob, except for one man who spared us after failing to identify us as Kuki. Fearing for our safety, we immediately sought help from a family friend who contacted the police. The police arrived promptly in their vehicles and rescued us from the imminent attack. Given the suddenness of the incident, we were unable to gather our belongings, including important documents and valuable items. We were escorted by the police to the 1st Manipur Rifle relief camp, where we sought refuge.

Considering the volatile situation, we decided to relocate to a safer location. With the assistance of the 1st Manipur Rifle, we requested transportation to Kangpokpi, where we have relatives. The 1st Manipur Rifle arranged three buses and five army trucks to facilitate our journey. However, as our convoy passed through the Koirengei area of Imphal, we were ambushed by a mob armed with stones and firearms. They even scattered nails on the road to hinder our progress. The attackers pursued us until we reached Gamgiphai and Motbung. Upon entering the Sadar Hills region, predominantly


