we are non-naga tribal Christians. I am a student and my mother is running a business as the sole breadwinner of the family along with my younger brother who is studying. We have incurred property damage of Rs. 7 lakhs and my possessions in the house have a value of over Rs. 10 lakhs.

My vehicle Yamaha Fascino worth over Rs. 80,000/-.

All our household items, washing machine, computer, refrigerator, safa set, 3 almirahs, 2 bed sets, dining set, clothes, wardrobe, are all lost. The mental trauma has been deep and agonizing as any sound triggers panic attack and sleepless nights follow me to this day. I wish I could someday have a full night's sleep.

There is no way we can continue to reside with the valley (Meitei) people in the valley. So, the only solution is separate administration so that the people in hills and valley can reside as neighbouring communities.

Hence we request you to restore normalcy and punish the perpetrators of these crimes and provide us a new home where we can feel safe and secure, as we are hoping for justice.

We are the residents of the above address since 11 years and have been staying in rented residence. On the 3rd May, 2023, at around 6:45pm, we heard the sound of war bells followed by loud blasts which we came to know were petrol bombs which were thrown into the houses in our neighbourhood. They also threw bricks, stones, rocks at our window, after which they threw the petrol bombs inside the windows. This attack went on incessantly for about 4-5 hours. With the help of the army, we went to the relief camp at Mantripukri on 5th May at around 10pm. Our relatives from outside Manipur helped us to book flight tickets and we managed to escape to Guwhati on the 10th May and eventually reach Shillong on 15th May. It was clear that the Meitei mob had attacked us with the help of Arambai Tenggol merely because
