



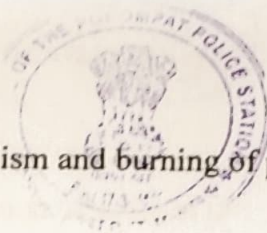

Subject: Report on looting, vandalism and burning of properties.

Sir,

I am to report that on 04-05-2023 at about 1:30 pm, my rented house situated at Haokip Veng, Mahabali Road, P.S. Porompat, Imphal East, was attacked by Meitei miscreants.

The criminals forced open the gate and destroyed, looted, vandalized and burnt down my rented house and other belongings noted below.

- (1). Three gold rings worth Rs. 1 Lakh.
- (2). Three Almirah worth Rs. 1,20,000/-.
- (3). Dressing Table worth Rs. 35,000/-.
- (4). Dunlop (3 nos.) – Rs. 25,000/-.
- (5). Gas Cylinder (3 nos.) – Rs. 15,000/-.
- (6). 2-wheeler Activa Scooter worth Rs. 90,000/-.
- (7). Wooden Bed worth Rs. 50,000/-.
- (8). Washing Machine worth Rs. 20,000/-.
- (9). Refrigerator worth Rs. 25,000/-.
- (10). Furniture Set worth Rs. 1 Lakh.
- (11). Utensils worth Rs. 1,50,000/-.
- (12). Blankets worth Rs. 1 Lakh.
- (13). Clothes worth Rs. 10,00,000/-.
