Sir,

I have the honour to state for kind consideration and necessary action that a police team of Lamphel PS led by me has conducted frisking and checking in prevailing law and order situation at Langol Lanthungching area today at 2.00 pm. While conducting frisking and checking, a Maruti 800 car bearing registration No.MN01AK-0547 driven by an unknown driver coming simultaneously from Langol Ningthou side towards Lamphel and a Beat car bearing registration No- Nil driven by an unknown driver in a very suspicious manner, violating the curfew order imposed by the District Magistrate- IW were detained for checking and verification at the spot. On spot verification of the Maruti 800 car the driver was identified as one Phairembam Premkumar Singh (38) S/o Ph. Surchandra Singh of Moirang Phairembam Leikai, Ward no. 6. On further questioning about the household items which he has kept inside his car. He disclosed that the materials have been stolen from the deserted houses of Langol areas. So, he was arrested on the spot at 2.30 pm and the vehicles along with the household materials were also seized at 2.40 pm by observing formalities. Whereas, again on spot verification of the Beat Car bearing registration- Nil the driver and co-driver identified themselves as one 1) Wangkhem Tomthin Singh (23) S/o W. Jugindro Singh of Yurembam Makha Leikai (Driver of Beat Car) and 2) Yumnam Yuhenba Singh (22 yrs) S/o. Y.Rajen Singh of Yurembam Makha Leikai. On questioning them, they stated that they have been stolen the household items from the deserted house located at Langol area. So, they were arrested on the spot at 2.55 pm and the vehicles along with the household materials were seized at 3 pm by observing formalities.

Therefore, I request you to kindly take necessary action against them. Thanking you for your kind co-operation.
