
the tribals (Kuki/Chin/Mizo/Hmar). Just before they reach our house, a miracle happened. A police man came to our rescue. He took us his uniform to avoid attention from the huge mob. He asked us where we wanted to go, since we couldn't get in the army camp and with the tension, fear and panic we didn't even know where we wanted to go. Then with his knowledge and will he drove us to the way of airport where we sometimes hid, sometimes came and drove back from the mob. It was really a matter of life and death as we witnessed burning of houses, road filled with smoke and dead bodies on the road side. With much effort we could hardly reach airport and took any available flight tickets. From there, we had to go to Kolkata since there were no tickets around North East. And from Kolkata we flew to Guwahati and from there we went to Shillong and stay with our relatives place.

The Meitei Tengols and Meitei Leepun attacked us because we are tribals. I am working as a teacher's assistant and my wife is a home maker. We have lost of properties and assets by the mob who came and attack our place which was amounted to 5 lakhs. Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and get justice from the Supreme Court and Central Government for all the loss of lives, property, rights and ill treatments from the state government and the Meitei miscreants.

We are hoping for Justice for us and for all who are in this situation and to book the culprits as per sections of the Law.
