miscreant of Meitei Community at Nongpok Ingkhol, New Checkon,
Imphal east Manipur.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that my rented room running as "AK
Garments Shops" located at Nongpok Ingkhol, New Checkon, Imphal east
District Manipur, comprising of clothes, shoes, shirts and all varieties of
clothes which includes 27 numbers of second hand belts consisting only
clothes and 27 numbers of second hand belts consisting of only Shoes has
been completely burnt down to ashes during Kuki and Meitei clashes by an
Unknown miscreant of Meitei Community on 22nd of May, 2023 at about 3:00
pm. The owner of the rented shops is the Building of Independent Church of
India, Secretariat, New Checkon, and Imphal. The estimated value lost and
burnt down is about 10, 00,000/- (Ten lakhs)

I shall be grateful for your kind co-operation and to take up necessary
legal action in this regard.
