Request for registration of Zero FIR in connection with the attack and looting of our house located at Subj: Sanjenthong under Porompat Police Station, Imphal East District on 4th May, 2023

Sir.

I would like to request registration of Zero FIR regarding the destruction of our house and property located at Sanjenthong, Patta no. 1476 Imphal East Porompat B 26(A) Nongpok Ingkhol 1992, on 4th May 2023 at about 4:00pm by the sudden attack of violent mob of about 1000 persons in number. At the time of the event, I was at home with my husband, my helper and my niece. My tenants were also upstairs in the flat above us. The mob suddenly came from the front gate and some of them climbed over the gate and destroyed the lock from the inside. My family and had to flee for our lives by climbing over the backyard tencing. The mob then proceeded to destroy all 3 storeys of our building including all the furnitures inside our house. They ransacked our house destroying and looting all the valuables and cash inside the almirahs, destroying beds, dressing tables, cabinets, chairs, sofa sets, kitchen racks, dining table and chairs, TV, fridge, washing machine and practically everything inside our compound. They also did not spare our 4 wheeler vehicles-one Mahindra Alturaz (MN01A G5305) and one Mahindra XUV500 (MN01X 8998) which they beat and crushed with iron rods, breaking all the glass and body. They also attempted to burn down the house and vehicles but could not proceed as the fire brigade arrived. My husband sustained physical injuries and several scratches on this forearm and leg from climbing over the fence not to mention the mental trauma which will probably accompany us for life. The cost of all our property destroyed on that day i.e 4th May 2023 would probably total up 10 crores. However, one cannot put a price on the attempt on our lives as some of the mob chased after us even while we ran for our lives.

It is not possible to lodge the report at Imphal as I have fled to Aizawl, Mizoram for fear of my life. I therefore request you to launch a full investigation into the events that happened on that day i.e 4th May 2023, so that all the culprits responsible and related to the event may be brought to justice and receive the highest punishment under law for their despicable actions.
