Sub: Complaint regarding illegal activation of SIM cards

Dear Sir,

With due respect, present complaints is being filed on behalf of Bharti Hexacom Limited (referred to as "Airtel" or "Company" hereinafter) a company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956 having its registered office at Bharti Crescent, 1, Nelson Mandela Road, Vasant Kunj, Phase II, New Delhi-110070 and Circle Office at Modrina Mansion, 1st Floor, Laitumkhrah Main Road, Shillong-793003 Meghalaya represented by the undersigned presently working as Head-Customer Experience, Bharti Hexacom Limited.

We would like to inform you that Bharti Hexacom Limited (Airtel) is a company engaged in providing mobile telephone service throughout the country including the North East Licensed Service Area. Being a telecom service provider while maintaining a huge subscriber base we also give emphasis on the activation of SIMs in accordance to the guidances/regulations in force. Through our Distributor Sales (PoS) who directly interact with the customers. Thereafter as per the process laid down by the Department of Telecommunications (DoT), Govt. of India, the Point of Sale completes all KYC related documentation and activates the SIM Cards as required by the customers. Basis the activation of SIM Cards with documents obtained from us for our telecom subscribers in the North East Licensed Service Area, it is established by the NE LSA of DoT that same photo with different subscriber's name is used for giving many mobile connections. These connections were treated as forged and as such we immediately disconnected all such connections considering the fact that such connections are misused which may result into law and order threat. In consideration to the above, we are filing this complaint against this Point of Sale (PoS) the details of which are attached and marked as Annexure A.

It is therefore requested that your good self may be pleased to investigate the matter and take action as per relevant provisions of law.
