I have the honour to report that on 03 May 2023 at around 1900 hrs, following on a mass rally of Tribal Solidarity Day of ATSUM (All Tribal Student Union Manipur) a large gathering of persons identified to be natives of kuki tribes gathered at my locality in a war footing manner including firing of guns and burning of houses which belongs to Meitei community.

During the said incident, my parents were residing at my ancestral home in Vill Thengra leirak of Churachandpur district at my maternal uncle's home namely Kangabam Premjit Singh. On 04 May 2023, my parents managed to escape from Churachandpur and moved to Changangei Uchekon and subsequently shifted to Shillong soon thereafter. Personal belongings of my family and valuable documents including my Training Certificate (Indian Military Academy) and a voter ID of my mother were looted/burned on the incident. List of items looted/burned on the incident is attached along with.

Therefore, I request you to kindly take necessary action at the earliest please.
