Sir,

I, Thangdoulia <sup>chinlam</sup> s/o of Changangei, Uchekon Imphal, am bringing to your kind notice that on the 4th May, 2023 (in broad daylight) my residence was attacked by a group of Meitei mobs.

These goons immediately broke my compound gate and vandalised, looted and burnt down all my valuable properties within the house with the worth Rs 7,49,900 (Seven Lakhs Forty Nine Thousands and Nine Hundreds). Amidst the criminal activities, I along with my family members managed to escape because of Divine Grace and fled to 1<sup>st</sup> Manipur Rifle (MR) Mantripukri for our safety and finally left the camp on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

Therefore, I request you to kindly take strong actions against the perpetrators by registering Zero FIR under relevant criminal sections of Indian Penal Codes.
