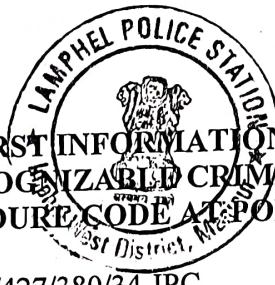

Subject: O- FIR regarding Licence Guns looted by Meitei Mob on 3&4/5/2023.

Sir,

In continuation of my O-FIR in connection with losses of properties burned and looted by Meitei Mobs on 3/5/2023 and 4/5/2023, I have the honour to state that I escaped with my family from the mob who tried to burn us alive on the night of 3/5/2023. While escaping in a hurry, our licenced guns of the family has been left along with some ammunitions. Details of the guns are given below for your kind tracking and return the same to the true owners.

- 1) One Old US Carbine, licence duly renewed in the name of Shri Dr. Jainson Haokip, Ex- Minister being elected two consecutive times from Tengnoupal Assembly Constituency from 1980 to 1990.
- 2) One DBBL short gun the name of Mrs. V. Roselind, Head Mistress of JB School.
- 3) One DBBL short gun in the name of Shri Joshua Khaiminlun Haokip, Probationary Officer of Canara Bank.

The above guns were checked and properly renewed as directed by the District Magistrate of Imphal West District in the last week of April, 2023.

I, therefore, request you to kindly traced the licenced guns and return the same to the authorised owners for self protection.
