As I fled immediately for my dear life, I don't know the status and conditions of my belongings all worth around Rs 8, 00,000 (Eight Lakhs).

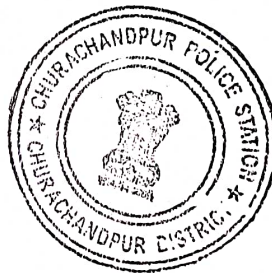
Amidst the criminal activities, I along with my family members managed to escape because of Divine Grace and fled to 143rd BN CRPF Lamphel for our safety on the same fateful day and finally left the camp on 10th May 2023.

Therefore, I request you to kindly take appropriate inquiry to check my residence and provide me the status as I find the situation too dangerous for me to check personally.
