Respected Sir,

An unprovoked incident happened on 3rd May 2023 in our village called Khuga Lampak, CCpur. That a large number of unknown miscreants suspected to be Kuki militants of about 200 in number along with lethal or sophisticated weapon approached to our village and started burning houses one after another. During the incident everybody were running after life to a safer place where there is security. And that very night everybody were gathered to a family camp and the next morning the Army personnel escorted and deported all of us to the Mini Secretariat CCpur at around 5:30 AM. (on 4-5-23). After leaving all the people from the village, the miscreants burnt the remaining houses.



In the very incident I left all my belongings in home and shop etc.

Some of the items which I left in my home are mentioned below:-

1. TV

2. Fridge, Washing Machine, Gas stove, 5 cylinders

3. 2 Laptops (DELL)

4. Furniture (6 tables, 3 Almshs, 3 Beds, 8 chairs)

5. Tools (Angle Grinder, Welding machine, Driller, Inverter, Hand tools, etc.)

6. Clothes (Women dresses, Men dresses, kids dresses, old woman dresses, Blankets, etc.)

7. Kids School Uniforms and books.

8. General books

9. Gold ornaments (25 sans of Necklace, Bracelets, Earrings, Rings)

10. Cash - About 2 lakhs

11. Scooty Activa Reg no. MN-02A 1724

12. Utensils (kitchen utensils)

13. House (semi Pucca, Toilet, Gate)

14. Miscellaneous - Water Pump 1HP, Dressing table,

15. Etc.

It is learnt that the above mentioned items are burnt or looted by the miscreants.



Besides my shop which is at Old Bazar, Zenthang Lamka was also looted by the miscreants.

Some of the items which were available at the shop were

1. 2 Deep Freezer
2. 1 Double Door Chiller Fridge
3. A.C. machine
4. CCTV camera set (4 channel)
5. Corolla Electret Generator 2.8 KV
6. 18 sets of steel racks for storing products.
7. Products for selling like Horlicks, Dry Fruit, Nuts, Biscuits, Cereals, Juices, Frozen Fruit, Sweets, milk, etc.

The estimated cost of my household properties is about Rs 58,61,000/- and cost of my shop is about Rs 10,00,000/-
