Kindly find enclosed herewith one Complaint letter receive from Paul Sodiantal, LDC (CAFEPD) Churachandpur on 5" November, 2023 regarding illegal capturing of OMSS rice by private individual (copy enclosed) wherein, it is mentioned that, FCI Manipur had issued a Release Order to Churachandpur District for lifting of 500 MT of OMSS rice till 18.11.2023. And on 04.11.2023, the first consignment (for 1750 bags of 50 kgs each, copy enclosed) of the aforesaid rice was requested from FCI Churachandpur for further distribution to all the Relief Camps located across various parts of the district, and some even remotely located at Singngat and Khoirentak. These were to be carried in 05 trucks (of 350 bags/ truck), to the temporary District Godown located at Mini Secretariat Tuibong and accordingly 03 trucks had completed the sortie. However, when the 4" truck (AS 01 DD 2624) was on its way to the district godown, at about 1830 hrssome private individuals illegally seized the said truck at Thingkangphai and took it to Royal Academy, D. Phailian, purportedly under the instructions of Mr. SonVualnam, President, Lamka Consumers Club (ECC). And also, that an appeal was made to the President, LCC, to request for the release of the OMSS rice of 350 bags which was illegally seized by the LCC, but it was not released. And also the said truck was taken out from Royal Academy, D. Phailian, on 05.11.2023 at about 0840 hrs, after they illegally kept at in their custody for more than 12 hrs,by coordinating with the district police, and when counted the truck had only 342 bags, despite the fact that in total 350 bags were lifted from the FCI godown

It is submitted that this illegal action was taken by Mr. Son Vualnam and his friends, without any proper legal authority and they had obstructed the normal movement of the government goods. To my knowledge, there was no prior notice, warning, or any legitimate reason provided for this illegal seizure. Further, there is an illegal misappropriation of 08 bags from the truck most probably by Mr. Son Vualnam and his friends when they took the truck in their custody for more than 12 hrs.

In the premises, it is therefore requested kindly take legal necessary action at an early date in this regard.

- That, FCI Manipur had issued a Release Order to Churachandpur District for lifting of 500 MT of OMSS rice till 18,11,2023.
- b) That, on 04.11.2023, the first consignment (for 1750 bags of 50 kgs each, copy enclosed) of the aforesaid rice was requested from FCI Churachandpur for further distribution to all the Relief Camps located across various parts of the district, and some even remotely located at Singngat and Khoirentak. These were to be carried in 05 trucks (of 350 bags/truck), to the temporary District Godown located at Mini Secretariat Tulbong and accordingly 03 trucks had completed the sortle. However, when the 4th truck (AS 01 DD 2624) was on its way to the district godown, at about 1830 hrs some private individuals illegally seized the said truck at Thingkangphal and took it to Royal Academy, D. Phailian, on 05.11.2023 at about 0840 hrs, after they illegally kept it in their custody for more than 12 hrs, by coordinating with the district police, and when counted the truck had only 342 bags, despite the fact that in total 350 bags were lifted from the FCI godown.

To my knowledge, there was no prior notice, warning, or any legitimate reason provided for this illegal seizure.
