Sir,

With due respect, i beg to state that on 10/07/2023 the village chief of L. Kannan namely S. Kaikhanlun Samte lodge a written compliant to OC/BHG-PS in which he stated that due to the outbreak of communal clash from date 03/05/2023 their village being situated at border areas have found insecure, as for the better safety of their villagers they have left their village on 02/06/2023 and stayed at grouping centre. During their absence in their village some unknown miscreants have stolen away their following properties.

1. Iron water pipe - 30 pieces (18 fth length)
2. Iron Channel (V) shape 20 piece (17 fth length)
3. One big size pipe 15 fth lenght meant for irregation of paddy field
4. 50 cement bags meant for construction of Police Outpost in their village
5. Iron bundles meant for construction of Police Outpost in their village.

They returned back to their village on 06/07/2023 and all the above mentioned properties in their village has been stolen away, they tried their level best to recover the lost properties but all effort gone in vain. As such the chief of the village lodge a written compliant.

During the course of investigation i visited the spot and made a proper inquiry in which the above mentioned regarding the lost of properties were found true.

I therefore pray that you would kindly looked into the matter and registered a regular case for smooth investigation of the case as per law.
