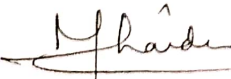

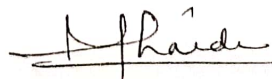

Respected Sir/Madam

We are the resident of the above address since 2006. On the 3rd May 2023, the Aarambai Tenggot, Meitei Leepun with state forces around 8:00pm ambush our locality with knives and guns. They shouted all kukis should be killed. I along with my family members 7 of us were hiding in the bathroom and under the bed. They started vandalizing our house. By that time we had off all the lights and around 4:30 Am, the CRPF came to evacuate us from our quarter to the relief camp.

I am a Uniform Service (3rd IRB) and my wife is under education Deptt. and now due to this conflict and issue I am unable to report to my work and my children are not able to attend their schools.

After we left our resident, they came back and looted our belongings. Our estimated properties including hardware & electrical items in our shop looted are around Rs. 91 lakhs. All our valuable documents have also been misplaced. Hardware store items worth Rs. 45 lakhs, expensive oil painting and materials, worth - B. 20 lakhs and total estimate

household appliances with two wheeler worth
Rs. 28 Lakhs - were all looted.

I along with my family are deeply traumatized
with the incident that happened to us. We believe
we are attacked solely because we belong to
Kuki. Hence I asked the higher authority to
compensate me for my losses. And bring justice
for me and my family. And to book the
culprits as per section of the law.
