

Respected sir,

We are the resident of the above address since 2000 till date. On the 4th May, 2023 I along with my family members and all kuki 20 tribes of village fled to the nearest safety place I,e CRPF camp, Lamphel on the morning of 4/5/2023. We have a narrow escape from the meiteis. All our private houses and govt. quarters were vandalize and our properties are looted. On the following days we fled to Guwahati on 11/5/23 and to Shillong on 13/5/23 we halted at St.Anthony's college guest house till today I,e 17/5/2023.

We were attacked solely because we belong to kuki- zo tribe and they want us to stay away from the valley. We were attacked by the Meitei mob combined with Arambai Tanggol and Meitei Leepun activists.

I am a Senior Subedar at Manipur police Training college, pangei. And my wife is a house wife looking after our 5kids. we are deeply traumatize with the situation that we are currently facing and we have lost tremendous amount of our property. The properties which were damaged by the miscreants amounted to Rs 10,95,000.00. Vehicles 1 bike-Rs 2,50000 and 1 Activa Rs 50,000. Electronic appliances worth up to Rs 2.50 lakhs.

Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and compensate our material lost during the ethnic cleansing.

We are hoping for justice and to book the culprits as per sections of law.
