

Respected Sir,

We are the residents of the above address since 30 years. On the 4th May, 2023, having heard that the Meitei mobs were on their way, we hastily left our quarter in a state of fear and confusion. We took refuge at a nearby army camp and left our car at a parking space. According to the instructions of the army personnel. After our first night at the camp, we came to learn that our car had been destroyed by the miscreants. On the 6th May, 2023 with the help of our relatives outside Manipur, we hopped on a plane and reached Shillong on the 7th May, 2023.

The Meitei mobs attacked us because we are tribals. I am a tetired government employee and I have two children.



We have lost of properties and assets by the mob who came and attack our place which was amounted to Rs. 14 Lakhs Rupees. My possessions which were inside the house was 60 Lakhs (Approx) More than this, we have lost one vehicle which cost around Rs. 13.8 Lakhs Rupees.

Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and relieve victims from this ethnic clash from all that they are going through by fighting for peace.

We are hoping for Justice for us and for all who are in this situation and to book the culprits as per sections of the Law.
