## Respected Sir,

We are the residents of the above address for the past two years. On the 4<sup>th</sup>, May, 2023 around morning time, Arambai Tengol and Meitei Leepuns, came to our locality and surrounded us. After that, they attacked us and burnt our houses. Later on, the Army came and rescued us guided us to the 86<sup>th</sup> Battlaion CRPC Camp for safety and shelter. And we were staying at the Camp for almost a week. On the 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2023, the Indian Army took us to the airport and flew us to Shillong. During that time, we feel that we could not trust the Manipur Police and Manipur Rifles since they were guiding the Arambai Tengol and Meitei Leepuns. During the first three days at the Camp, we felt insecure because the Tengols and Leepuns were taking the guns of the police from the police stations and were wearing their uniforms. My properties which were being damaged by the miscreants were amounted to Rs. 13,15,092( Thirteen Lakhs Fifteen Thousand Ninety Two Rupees)

Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and help us get financial help to build my home back, protect my property back in my village from encroachment.

We are hoping for Justice for us and for all who are in this situation.
