



Subject: Report on looting, vandalism and burning down of properties.

Sir,

With due respect, I am to report that on 04/05/2023 at around 1:30 p.m, a large group of Meitei miscreants attacked Haokip Veng, Imphal East, in that my variety shop i.e. M/S Genesis Store bearing License No. IMC/73(19)/21, located at Haokip Veng, Imphal East, which was dealing in various services such as stationery, grocery, etc., was forcefully opened, vandalized, looted and burnt down by the said miscreants.

List of properties which were damaged, looted and burnt down are as follows:

1. Ice-Cream freezer (320 Litres) – 01 worth Rs. 35,000/-
2. Commercial Refrigerator (550 Litres) – 01 worth Rs. 49,000/-
3. Coffee Machine 3 outlets – 01 worth Rs. 29,000/-
4. Electronic Weighing Machine – 01 worth Rs. 3,500/-
5. Counter Table – 01 worth Rs. 25,000/-
6. Wooden Rack – 08 worth Rs. 16,000/-
7. Chairs – 10 worth Rs. 4,000/-
8. Ladder – 01 worth Rs. 5,000/-
9. Coffee Table – 02 worth Rs. 18,000/-
10. Plastic Rack – 04 worth Rs. 16,000/-
11. Stools – 10 worth Rs. 3,000/-
12. Grocery items worth Rs. 4,35,000/-
13. Bakery items worth Rs. 20,000/-
14. Variety / Stationery items worth Rs. 1,30,000/-

Grand Total – Rs. 5,85,000/-

It is therefore requested to kindly take up necessary legal action against the unknown culprits. Cause of delay in reporting on time is due to my displacement and volatile law and order situation.
