Today i.e. 18/01/2024 at around 01.20 PM, a huge mob led by Youths of Manipur (a social organisation of youths) along with womenfolk's from relief camps were coming from Singjamei sides and gathered together at Yaiskul near Krishna Premi Oil Pump, Imphal. The mob was huge in numbers nearly about 1000 individuals. Immediately, a police team of Imphal West District led by Superintendent of Police rushed at the said area where the mob was asked to disperse from the place and not to cross beyond the Krishna Premi Oil Pump junction. They were informed not to stage the unlawful assembly where the huge mob blocked the National Highway 102 at Yaiskul opp Hicham Yaicham Pat. The situation became worse and the mob was out of control. So, the RAF & CRPF personnel also arrived at the spot as requisitioned by Superintendent of Police, Imphal West. Further at around 01:40 PM the security forces resorted to the use of non-lethal weapon like Tear Smoke Shell (long & short range) to disperse the mob with the permission concerned Magistrate.

Hence, a suo-motu case under FIR No. 17(01)2024 IPS U/s 147/148/149/188/34 IPC has been registered against the individuals who form the unruly mob for investigation.
