





Received information that on 13/01/21024 at @ 5:45 pm one Bolero Ambulance B/Regd. No. MN01S 2605 white in colour which was transporting some Medicine cartoon to Haochong Primary Health Centre from Imphal was detained by some armed miscreants at Kangchup Chingkhong. Further the armed miscreants demanded documents relating the Medicine loaded in the Bolero ambulance but could not produce the documents at the time. As such the armed miscreants falsely accused the driver namely Michael Inka of transporting the Medicine for Kukis. Further the armed miscreants assaulted the said driver. However, the local Maira Paibis intervened and safely brought the driver along with three passengers at Phayeng and released.

Hence a case under FIR No. 4(1)2024 LSG-PS U/S 339/353/325/506/34 IPC, 25(1-B)Arms Act has been registered Suo-motto against the unknown armed miscreants for investigation.
