With reference to the above cited subject, I have the honour to report to you as follows:

- 1. That, I am a Scheduled Tribe belonging to the Hund Tribe, which is a recognized

 Tribe under the Constitution of India. And, I am a permanent resident of Game Village Foa

 Village, P.O.-Ramplel

 Manipur.
- 2. That, on the 3., 2023, at about 9. AM/PM, a huge contingent of armed radical Meitei/ Meeteis suspected to be members of the Arambai Tenggol and Meitei Leepun headed by the Manipur State forces like the Manipur Police Commando and the Indian Reserved Battalion (IRB) attacked our village and in the process, they have looted, vandalized and torched my house.
 - 3. That, it may be reported here that the miscreants were shouting slogans like"KANGLEIPAK YAIPHARE"; "KUKI HATLO"; "HAO HATLO"; etc. while they were
 carrying out their criminal activities. It seems to me that all these has taken place at the
 instance of the Manipur State Government as the perpetrators openly claimed and
 shouted that nobody would stop them, even the police because everyone, including top
 officials of the Manipur Government are patronizing them and that that no harm could be
 done to them.
 - 4. That, at the time of the attack we somehow managed to escape to save our lives under the compelling circumstances and thus could not take our belongings including important documents like Pension Card, Aadhar Card, ATM Card, PAN Card, educational certificates, etc. apart from other tangible materials. A list of our properties looted/destroyed/ burnt is attached here under with its estimated costs. The total loss suffered is estimated to be about Rs. 6, 0000 (Rupees.
