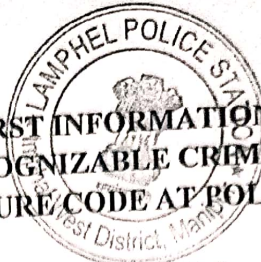

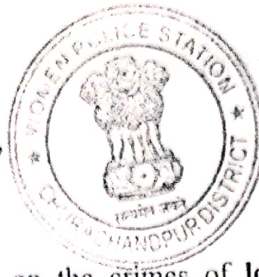

Subject: - Complaint/ Report on the crimes of looting, vandalism and discrimination of Scheduled Tribes.

Dear Madam,

With reference to the above cited subject, I have the honour to report to you as follows:

1. That, I am an Ex-Serviceman belonging to the Simte Tribe, which is a recognized Tribe under the Constitution of India. And, I am an occupant of a Govt. quarter at Langol National Game Village, No. B/71, Zone IV, P.O. & P.S.- Lamphelpat, District- Imphal West, Manipur which was in the name of my wife, Mrs. Kim Khan Niang, LDC, State Academy of Training, Takyelpat, Imphal.
2. That, on the 4th of May, 2023, at about 8:00 AM, a huge contingent of armed radical Meitei/ Meeteis suspected to be members of the Arambai Tenggol and Meitei Leepun attacked our locality and in the process, they have looted and vandalized my quarter which is situated at the above mentioned address. While we fled from the area to save ourselves.
3. That, it may be reported here that the miscreants were shouting slogans like- "KANGLEIPAK YAIPHARE"; "KUKI HATLO"; "HAO HATLO"; etc. while they were carrying out their criminal activities. It seems to me that all these has taken place at the instance of the Manipur State Government as the perpetrators openly claimed and shouted that nobody would stop them, even the police because everyone, including top officials of the Manipur Government are patronizing them and that that no harm could be done to them.
4. That, at the time of the attack we somehow managed to escape to save our lives under the compelling circumstances and took shelter at the AR Camp in New Keithel Manbi and we could not take our belongings and were looted or vandalized by the said miscreants. A list of our properties looted/ destroyed is attached here under with its estimated costs. The total loss suffered is estimated to be about **Rs. 74,50,000/- (Rupees Seventy four Lakhs Fifty Thousand) only**
