Subject – Report on crimes of vandalism, looting, arson-attack, criminal infimidation, unlawful displacement and discrimination of Scheduled Tailer

Dear Madam,

With reference to the above cited subject, I have the honour to report to you as follows:

That, I am a Scheduled Tribe belonging to the *Hmar Tribe*, which is a recognized Tribe under the Constitution of India, by virtue of which I am being entitled to the protection under The SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

That, due to financial issues, I and my family moved into my Cousin brother's quarter, namely Emmanuel Zote(7005326719) who is an Orthopedic Attendant(regular) in RIMS, located at C/21, Type II, near CRPF Camp, P.O. & P.S.- Lamphalpat, district-Imphal West. And, we deserted the said quarter on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May,2023 at around 7:00PM because of the ethnic crisis prevailing in and around Imphal. It has come to our knowledge that the deserted quarter was looted and vandalized on the 20th of August, 2023 at around 10:00AM along with the Two-Wheeler (details given below) which was torched / burned down.

The criminals who are suspected to be members of Arambai Tenggol and Meetei Leepun, broke open the door, destroyed and looted every valuable property from the said quarter worth about Rs.30,09,700/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs Nine Thousand Seven Hundred) only.

That, it may be reported here that the miscreants were shouting slogans like- "KANGLEIPAK YAIPHARE"; "KUKI HATLO"; "HAO HATLO"; etc. while they were carrying out their criminal activities. It seems to me that all these has taken place at the instance of the Manipur State Government as the perpetrators openly claimed and shouted that nobody would stop them, even the police because everyone, including top officials of the Manipur Government are patronizing them and that that no harm could be done to them.
