Subject: Information regarding incidence of loot and arson at my residence in Paite-Veng, Sangaipron Kwakeithel Imphal under Ballier Ct. 10 Sangaiprou, Kwakeithel, Imphal, under Police Station, Lamphel Imphal, on 3rd & 4th May

Sir.

I, the undersigned Mr. Khailian Thang Vaiphei residing in a rented house of Mr. John Suanlian Hauzel in Paite-Veng, Sangaiprou, Kwakeithel, Imphal, under Lamphel Police Station, Imphal, would like to make a report that, on the 3rd of May 2023, at about 8pm, a large mob had gathered in the locality of Paite-Veng and started attacking the houses belonging to the tribals. As the violent mob started burning the houses of the tribals in the locality, I was fearing for the safety of my family, so all of us, including my wife Mrs Margaret, my son Goulal 15yrs, another girl and boy from my village climbed over the wall of my neighbour towards the western side and further climbed to the compound of Dr Imo, where we silently sat in the verandah as he was not responding to our knocking on the door. From there we could see and hear the mob breaking our doors and windows and started looting our household belongings. At about 1:30 am on 4th May 2023, we could hear the police force firing tear gas and dispersing the violent mob, gathering enough courage we climbed back to our compound and silently came out of the gate where we met the police in several vehicles. The police evacuated me and my family to the 1st Bn Manipur Rifles. The very same day the 4th May 2023, at about 12;00 noon we heard that our house has been completely burned down by the violent mob.

All my household items and also important documents like passport, educational certificates, bank passbook, voter id etc have been either looted or burned down by the violent mob. The value of all the items varying from bed, sofas, almirah, electronic items, kitchen items etc. is approximately rupees 60 lakhs. Making a detailed list is not possible as

the number of items is too enormous.

I could not make the report earlier as I had to leave Imphal immediately for Shillong for the safety of myself and my family and also in the hope and expectation that the situation will improve soon and that I would be able to make the report personally at Lamphel Police Station itself. As the situation has not improved till date and is not possible for me to file my report at the concerning police station, I request you to kindly register a zero FIR at Churachandpur Police Station and forward it to the Lamphel Police Station Imphal for further necessary action.
