Subject: - Report

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e., 03/01/2024 at around 1.30 pm, while I along with my team were conducting random frisking and checking of vehicles plying along NH-37 at Leingangpokpi Police out Post, Jiribam, one vehicle Bolero bearing regd. No. AS 02AL- 7707 white in colour came towards the frisking and checking point from Imphal side towards Jiribam driven by one unknown driver and the vehicle was stopped for checking. On checking of the vehicle, found one male driver and 2 (two) women occupants and 2 (two) children inside the vehicle.

On verification of the occupants of the vehicle one after another, they identified themselves as- (i) Pranab Kumar Das (30) yrs S/O Prasen Das of 86 Doboka Road near Kali Mandir, Barjari, Rajarail, Jamunamukh Nagaon, Assam (driver and said to be the owner of the vehicle), (ii) Gaibangliu Kahmei (20) yrs D/O Poukinthuan Kahmei of Khumji II, Noney District, Manipur, (iii) Gaiduanliu Kamei (30) yrs W/O. Papu Das of 86 Doboka Road near Kali Mandir, Barjari, Rajarail, Jamunamukh, Nagaon, Assam A/P- Khumji (Lukhambi), Haochong, Noney District, Manipur with her 2 (two) children namely (a) Lucus Das (6) yrs and (b) Zoya Das (4 months). Then, I introduced myself to them as SI. K. Sanatomba Singh, In-Charge, Leingangpokpi Police Out Post, Jiribam. Further, on checking of the vehicle, one black polythene bag was found concealed inside the bonnet near the battery of the vehicle. On spot questioning about the content of the polythene bag, the driver of the vehicle namely Pranab Kumar Das admitted that the polythene bag contain some contraband drugs which he kept concealed for transportation. He also stated that all the other occupants of the vehicle have no knowledge of transportation of the drugs and also have no involvement in this regard.

Immediately, the matter was informed to Shri. T. Inaobi Singh (MPS) SDPO/Jiribam and also requested to inform Executive Magistrate, Jiribam. At the same time I have also approached one civilian who run grocery shop nearby the Police Out Post namely Shamurailatpam Brajadhon Sharma with a request to witness while observing formalities. Subsequently, Shri. T. Inaobi Singh (MPS) SDPO/Jiribam and one Executive Magistrate, Jiribam namely Shri. Hijam Clington Luwang arrived at the spot and taken out the said black polythene bag from the concealing area in presence of the driver, the 2 (two) women occupants and the civilian. Then, on opening of the said black polythene bag, found 5 (five) nos. of soap caps containing brown colour powder (suspected to be contraband drugs).

Further, all the 5 (five) nos. of soap caps were marked as A-1 to A-5 and weighed one after another by using weighing machine and found as "A-1 = 13.00 grams, A-2 = 11.81 grams, A-3 = 12.69 grams, A-4 = 15.61 grams and A-5 = 12.47 grams (in total 65.58 grams excluding the weight of soap caps)".

Then, all the soap caps i.e. "A-1" to "A-5" along with the said black polythene bag were put inside a cartoon box and wrapped with plain white cloth and packed & sealed by using wax with a five rupee coin and marked as "P" as parent packet. Thereafter, the driver of the vehicle, the 2 (two) women occupants and the civilian and the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam have put their signatures on that parent packet "P". The parent packet "P" having inside 5 (five) nos. of soap caps containing brown colour powder (suspected to be contraband drugs), the vehicle Bolero bearing regd. No. AS 02AL-7707, 2 (two) nos. of Mobile handset (one I-phone & one 1+) belonging to the accused person were seized from the possession of the accused person namely **Pranab Kumar Das (30) yrs S/O. Prasen Das of 86 Doboka Road near Kali Mandir, Barjari, Rajarail, PO & PS- Jamunamukh, Dist.- Nagaon, Assam (driver of the vehicle)** by preparing a formal Seizure Memo at 2:30 pm (of 03/01/2024) in presence of all the witnesses and the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam.

Thereafter, on that Seizure Memo, the 2 (two) women occupants and the civilian namely Shri. Shamurailatpam Brajadhon Sharma have put their respective signatures as witnesses. The Executive Magistrate, Jiribam has also put his signature on the Seizure Memo. The accused person has also put his signature on the Seizure Memo. Subsequently, the accused person was arrested at 2:40 pm (of 03/01/2024).

The arrested accused person and the seized items are hereby handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
