**Sub: FIR against bike theft bearing registration number MN1Z 2399**

Sir,

I the undersigned have the honour to state the following for your kind consideration thereof. That I had given a two wheeler **Yamaha R15** bearing **Registration number MN1Z 2399**, **chassis number ME11CKO14C2018894**, that belonged to my brother **Majiwangbou** to Mr. Arjun who owned a workshop at Kalapahar. I had even paid him Rs 15000 for buying the parts which was necessary to repair the bike. But due to the unfortunate ongoing ethnic clash that began on may 3<sup>rd</sup> I am told that Mr. Arjun had abandoned the workshop . And that I could not get in touch with him due to the crisis, therefore I went to look for my bike on 11<sup>th</sup> September, and it was found missing from the garage. On further enquiry I was told by residents of Tumnokpokpi that a few days back some few people had come and taken a few bikes (including an R15) from the garage and when the youths and neighbours inquired of them, they said it was their bikes and uploaded them in an auto and sped off.

Therefore I would like to file an FIR against the culprits who have stolen my bike and that the same might be retrieved, for which act of kindness I shall remain ever grateful.
