Today, on 25/02/2023 at around 1230 hrs, a joint team of Kangpokpi District Police, 4th IAB Re(MPTC) and 30m Canteen Magistrate) Thingfen Block, Kangpokpi District, numbering about 115 (one hundred and fifteen) persons led by Shri L. Laminang Khunlai, mps, D.S.P. 45pm/KPI and Capt. B. Lanthang Vaphue of Saitul-PS under the supervision of Shri Th. Vekhrangit Seigh mps, sp/KPI, carried out a mass destruction of illicit poppy plants cultivation at the hill range of Thingphai Village under Thingfen Sub. Division, Kangpokpi District, Manipur about 30 kms North from Saitul Police Station in which illegal poppy plantation of land covering about 10 (ten) acres were totally destroyed. Hence the case.
