




I the undersigned have the honour to state that on 17th May, 2023 at about 7:30 pm, some unknown persons holding arms with deadly weapons numbering about 700 suspected to be Kuki community from different villages were entered in my rented tailoring shop, "OPEN TAILOR" located at Saikul Bazar, Kangpokpi District, Manipur and vandalised the said tailor shop. The owner of rented tailor shop is Helkhohao, Saikul Bazar.

The following properties of my tailoring shop were damaged in the incident.

1. Sewing machines (10 Nos.)	-	Rs 1, 50, 000/-
2. Clothes (Stitch and unstitch bales)	-	Rs. 3, 90, 000/-
3. School bags (for school supply)	-	Rs. 1,45, 000/-
4. T-Shirts (for school supply)	-	Rs. 1, 20, 000/-
5. School belt (for supply)	-	Rs. 35, 000/-
6. Tailoring materials	-	Rs. 90, 000/-
7. Cash amount	-	Rs. 80,000/-
8. Kitchen items	-	Rs. 90, 000/-
