As soon as I, Shri Ng. Anthony Smith, Inspector, o/c SKL-PS joined the Kangpokpi District Police as o/c Saiket PS on 12/01/2022, just before the 12th Manipur Legislative Assembly Election, I verbally reported to SP/DPG. Statuing on 12/01/2022 i.e. on the day of taking charge as o/c/SKL-PS, after carrying out checking of arms and Ammunition in the Arun Kote, of arms getting late and hence the exhibits C (including the Grenade) were not properly arranged in the malkhang. It was not safe to check the malkhang. Moreover I was informed by some persons of SKL-PS that proper handing and taking of the malkhang of Saiket-PS has been done since the last 10 years. So Shri Thangpu Kejiga, Inspector, the previous o/c/Saiket PS agreed to carry out handing & taking of malkhang on another day as soon as possible whenever Inspector Thangpu Kejiga is available.

That, as no handing & taking of the malkhang could be done on the said date, Inspector Thangpu Kejiga locked the malkhang and took the keys of the malkhang with him and I counter locked the malkhang using another lock and kept the keys with me so that the malkhang could be opened only when both Inspector Thangpu Kejiga and I are present.

That, Inspector Thangpu Kejiga could not turn up at Saiket-PS due to busy schedule because of the State Assembly Election 2022. So I reported the matter to SP/Kangpokpi requesting for constituting a Committee for checking the malkhang of Saiket-PS. Accordingly, SP/Kangpokpi advised me to submit it in writing, due to the election, the matter would not be looked into.

That, after the Election, I submit a letter dated 12th March 2022 (a copy enclosed) to SP/Kangpokpi requesting for constituting a committee for checking the malkhang of Saiket-PS and the reason for not being able to take up the malkhang charge of Saiket-PS earlier (a copy enclosed).

That, the Superintendent of Police, Kangpokpi District, issued an order vide order No B-1115/ SP-14P/2009 (SP-02009) /117 dated 25/03/2022 (A copy enclosed) constituting a special committee comprising members namely, 1) Inspector Ng. Anthony Sengch, OC/Saiter-PS and 2) SI. Helginthay Bumael of Saiter-PS and headed by Shri Abel Kalan, Mps. Addl. SP (Cops), Kangpokpi as Chairman for Checking the malkhaus of Saiter-PS.

The Additional Superintendent of Police (Cops), Kangpokpi district, issued an order vide order No B-1514P (Cops)-14P/2022 dated 6th April 2022 for Checking of malkhaus of Saiter-PS on 11th, 12th and 13th of April 2022 accordingly. The Checking of malkhaus of Saiter-PS on 11th, 12th and 13th of April 2022 in presence of the previous officers of Saiter-PS (Inspector Thayppu Kyogn). Checking was not carried out on 11th April 2022 as Inspector Thayppu Kyogn, the previous officer of Saiter-PS was not available on the day.

That, as the checking of malkhaus could not be completed on 13th April 2022, the Addl. Cops & SP of Police (Cops), Kangpokpi issued another order vide order No B-1514P (Cops)-14P/2022 (order) dated 14th April 2022 (A copy enclosed) for continuing the checking of malkhaus on 14th, 15th and 20th of April 2022.

That, Checking of the malkhaus of Saiter-PS are conducted on 18th April 2022 in presence of the previous officers of Saiter-PS, during the checking, some exhibits were found missing or suspicious to be manipulated and exhibit contraband (Gangs) for 7C Serum (can) numbers of case could not be identified as the exhibits are in a dilapidated condition and there are signs of Gangs eaten by rats etc. Instead of about 24965 kgs of Gangs were found in the malkhaus/godown. Detailed statement of missing exhibits are enclosed as annexure "A" and Annexure "B".

So, a legal case under P.M.R.A 19(3) 2021/Case-15 of 20/4/09, 120-B & 29 Police Act 1861, has been registered on 26-04-2022 with H.C. (The Special Committee to no higher authority and waited for further orders).
