Sir, I have the honour to state, that on 03-5-2023 at around 11:30 pm some unknown miscreants suspected to be hills tribal people numbering about 1500 person entered our village Thangal Bazar, PO - Saikul, PS - Saikul, Kangpokpi - District Manipur having 18 houses about 4km South from Saikul PS. They burnt down all our houses including our furnitures, Electronic items, Utensils, Jewellery, Clothes foods and grains etc to ground leaving all of us homeless. The approximate value of lost property is calculated at about Rs 18-20 Crores.

It is therefore requested to kindly register a regular case without delay and booked the culprits and take necessary legal action against them according to law.
