Sub: Report

Sir.

I have the honour to state that today i.e. On 7/12/2022 at about 5:30pm a combined teams of SKL+PS led by SI Seiginten Kipgen and 22 AR COB Saikul led by Major Bhopesh Sharma while conducting interview picking and checking at Saikul village near Water Supply based on the information of suspicious movement of drug peddlers at Saikul village near Water Supply one scooter NTOKA 125, Red and Black in colour with no registration number was stopped and during checking by the Police and 22 AR teams, the rider was found behaving in a very suspicious manner. The rider was interrogated at the spot and on preliminary interrogation, he admitted himself as drug peddler transporting illegal drugs from Mayang village to Imphal along Saikul to Imphal road and also admitted that he is in possession of suspected brown sugar in his scooter. The rider of the scooter identified himself as Ngamlenthang Khongrai (32) S/o Chinyang Khongrai of Mayang Village, POIPS - Saikul, Kangpokpi, Manipur.

On further interrogation of Ngamlenthang Khongrai (32) S/o Chinyang Khongrai of Mayang Village, POIPS - Saikul he disclosed that he procured the drug and produced it from opium collected from different villages.

On interrogation he disclosed that he was transporting the drugs to bosph for selling it to one Tabui (Muslim). However, he could not sell the drugs as they could not meet.

In the meantime, on confirming the presence of drugs in the scooter no further checking was done in order to observe formalities at the spot. So, immediately Senior Officers of the district namely Shri Md Abul Kalam, MDS ASP (OP) and Insp'tg Anthony Suresh, OC/ISKL-PS were informed. 1 (one) Executive Magistrate was also requisitioned to be present in conducting checking of the scooter and accordingly Shri Bhupanga Maibam, SDO/ISKL was deputed by DC Office Kangpokpi. The scooter was searched in the presence of the above aforesaid Executive Magistrate and in the presence of the Executive Magistrate Shri Ngamlenthang Khongrai (32) S/o Chinyang Khongrai of Mayang village, was made to retrieve the drugs from the scooter.

The transparent plastic packet was retrieved by Ngamlenthang Khongrai (32) S/o Chinyang Khongrai of Mayang village in the presence of the Executive magistrate deputed by DC office and in presence of independent witness. The six polythene packet marked as ABC... F were packed and sealed in a parcel box in the presence of the aforesaid noted witness.

Particulars of seized articles

- ① 6 (Six) transparent polythene packet suspected to be brown sugar having total weight of about 3.046 kgs.
- ② 1 (one) Aadhar Card, on the name of Ngamlenhang Khongsa s/o Chuiyang Khongsa of Maoyang village.
- ③ 1 (one) Scooty NTORG 125 Red and Black colour without regd. number.
- ④ 1 (one) Oppo Phone with two sim cards jio (883724013) and Birtel sim (9862753432)
- ⑤ Indian currency Rs. 1200/-
