Sub-Report

Sir,

I have the honour to state that on 28-05-2023 at around some unknown miscreants suspected to be a members of Meitei Youth Organisation, Meitei Iepum, Kangleipak Kamba Lup (KKL), Arambai Tenggol and World Meitei Council (WMC) Schedule Tribe Demand Committee (STDC) numbering about 900-1000 persons carrying sophisticated weapons like AK Rifles, SLR, INSAS and 303 Rifles forcefully entered our village, P. Phaimol Village, Thungtin Sub-Division, Kangpokpi District Manipur having 27 houses about 20km South from Saikul-PS They fired several round of automatic weapons toward us for about 1 (one) hours. So we fled from our village fearing lost of life.

They burnt down all our houses to ground leaving all of us homeless. In addition to they also burnt down our Church Community hall, Church office, two tractors, 3 cars, 1 thresher, 1 Rice mill, groceries shops, 27 Grainaries, 7 Two wheelers etc.

The approximate value of lost property is calculated at about Rs 50,00,00,000/- (fifty Crores)

It is, therefore requested to kindly register a regular case without delay and booked the culprit and take necessary legal action against them according to law.
