Sub: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that today i.e on 18/11/2022 at about 1:30 pm teams of KPI-PS led by SI S. Raju Singh and SI S.L. Seiminthang while conducting intensive frisking and checking near Lungphou village along with personnel of 22 AR, COB Kangpokpi under the overall instruction of SP/KPI, ASP(Ops) Kangpokpi and under the direct supervision of OC/KPI based on the information of suspicious movement of drug peddlers on the intersecting road of Lungphou IVR to IT-Road, One Maruti Gypsy, white in colour with no registration number was stopped and during checking by the Police and 22 AR teams, two occupants inside the car were found behaving in a very suspicious manner. The two occupants were interrogated separately at the spot and on preliminary interrogation, they admitted themselves as drug peddlers transporting illegal drugs along the highway and also admitted that they were in possession of suspected Heroin No. 4 in their vehicle. The driver of the vehicle and his associate were identified as Kaidiwangbou Abonmai (30) S/o Paochamlungbou Abonmai of Makhan Village, Makhan, Senapati, Manipur-795136 and Prem Bahadur Khatiwoda (24) S/o Surabir Khatiwoda of Kathikho Karong, PO Karong, PS-Senapati respectively.

On further interrogation of Kaidiwangbou Abonmai (30) S/o Paochamlungbou Abonmai of Makhan Village, he divulged that he obtained the drugs from one Gounu of Kangpokpi. Immediately a team was dispatched and she was identified by Kaidiwangbou Abonmai (30) S/o Paochamlungbou Abonmai. She was later identified as Lamhoineng Kipgen (39) W/o Haokholen Kipgen of Phaicham Veng, Kangpokpi Ward No. 1. House search was conducted at her residence by the police team along with women police personnel and recovered 2(two) Mobile phone from her possession. On interrogation she admitted that the drugs were obtained from her and she was taken to Kangpokpi Police Station for further verification at 3:30 pm. on the same day.

In the meantime, on confirming the presence of drugs in the vehicle no further checking was done in order to observe formalities at the spot. So, immediately Senior Officers of the district namely Shri Md. Abul Kalam, MPS, ASP(Ops) and Inspt. Henminthang Kipgen, OC/KPI were informed. 1 (one) Executive Magistrate was also requisitioned to be present in conducting checking of the vehicle and accordingly Shri Lhunkhopao Touthang, SDC-HQ of DC Office was deputed by DC Office, Kangpokpi. The Vehicle was searched in the presence of the above aforesaid senior Officers of the district and in the presence of the Executive Magistrate. Shri Kaidiwangbou Abonmai (30) S/o Paochamlungbou Abonmai of Makhan Village was made to retrieve the contraband from the Gypsy. He unscrewed the spare tyre placed at the back door of the vehicle. The tyre was removed but retrieving the concealed contraband was not possible without the aid of suitable appliances so a mechanic was requisitioned and Shri Peter Kshetrimayum (29) S/o Gudhoni of Chingmang, Leimakhong and at present working as a mechanic at Basanta Workshop was sent by the workshop owner along with the required tools for opening the Spare Tyre. The spare tyre of Gypsy with inscription wrangler RT /S of Good-year brand, 215/75R15(1005) was opened by Peter Kshetrimayum and on opening contraband drugs in plastic soap cases was found concealed neatly. The plastic soap cases was retrieved by



the mechanic in the presence of the executive magistrate deputed by DC Office and marked as 1, 2, 3.....and it totals to 64 soap cases of suspected Heroin No. 4. The 64 Soap cases after marking 1,2,3... till 64 were distributed into two lots and weighed. Lot-1 numbering from 1,2,3...till 32 weighs 1.450 Kgs (along with the weight of the plastic soap cases) and Lot-2 numbering 33,34.....till 64 weighs 1.440 Kgs (along with the weight of the plastic soap cases). The combined weight of Lot-1 and Lot-2 is 2.890 Kgs (along with the weight of the plastic soap cases).

The recovered 64 soap cases containing suspected Heroin no. 4 and other articles were seized in presence of executive magistrate, witnesses and apprehended persons by preparing a formal seizure memo at 5:30 pm. The apprehended persons were also arrested on the same day in the presence of executive magistrate and witnesses by preparing a formal arrest-memo. The owner of the seized drugs namely Lamhoineng Kipgen (39) W/o Haokholen Kipgen of Phaicham Veng, Kangpokpi Ward No. 1 was also arrested on the same day.

1. 64 (sixty four) Soap cases of Suspected Heroin No. 4 in plastic Soap cases.
2. One Maruti Gypsy, White in colour without registration number
3. One Spare tyre with inscription wrangler RT /S of Good-year brand, 215/75R15(1005)
4. Three mobile Smart phones of Redmi Brand with numbers 8119877452 Airtel SIM , 8730856571 of Airtel SIM ,918798783059 of Airtel and 7005489686 of Jio Sim.
5. 1(one) Nokia Keypad phone with 918798927074 of Airtel sim.
6. Aadhar Card bearing No. 280157032918 in the name of Kaidiwangbou Abonmai

Following the order passed by the Hon'ble Spl. Judge, ND&PS, Manipur vide No. SPL-C/ND&PS/2019/659-663 dated 26-11-2019 corresponding Cril. Appeal No. 652 of 2012 (MANU/SC/0073/2016: (2016) 3 SC & 379) the necessary proceedings laid under ND&PS Act will be observed before the Hon'ble Court of JMFC, Kangpokpi.

Therefore, the arrested three accused persons and seized items are handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action please.
