Sir,

Today i.e. On 17/1/2023 at around 10:30 am a joint team of Kangpokpi District police, NAB, MR/IRB and Forest department, Kangpokpi, SDO Lhunglin block, Kangpokpi District, numbering about 273 (two hundred seventy three) Persons led by Shri. Th. Vikramjit Singh MPS, SP/KPI carried out a mass destruction of illicit Poppy plants cultivation at Lhangsom hill ranges under Lhunglin Sub-Division, Kangpokpi District, Manipur about 25 kms North from the Saikul Police Station in which illegal Poppy plantation of land covering about 42 (forty two) acres were totally destroyed. It is therefore, request to take up necessary legal action against Shri Sangthang Hakep (60) yrs chief of Lhangsom village, Kangpokpi District, Manipur.
