Subject: Submission of recovered weapons and ammunitions

Sir,

I am writing to report the recovery and subsequent submission of a cache of weapons and ammunitions as part of an operation conducted by a joint team of 16 Assam Rifles and District Police Kangpokpi, in accordance with the specific input received on 08 February 2024.

On the aforementioned date, specific input was shared by intelligent agency regarding the presence of a cache of small arms and ammunitions in the general area of N. Changoubung approximately 10 km North West of N. Changoubung in Kangpokpi District, Manipur. In response to this information, a column consisting of one Officer, one Junior Commissioned Officer (JCO) and sixteen other ranks (OR) from 16 Assam Rifles established two mobile vehicle check post at Hengbung and Changoubung. The vehicle patrol on the IVR(Inter Village Road) road observed movement of few individuals on the road at around 0335 hrs. on 09 Feb 2024. On challenging the individuals ran away. The incident was immediately informed to the police control room KPI at 0345 hrs. A joint team of 16 Assam Rifles and KPI Police Station launched a search operation at 0900 hrs. At around 1310 hours a suspicious patch covered with foliage was found. The joint team removed the foliage using a long stick and found a cache of weapon.

After conducting a meticulous search for over four hours, the following small arms and ammunitions and explosive were successfully recovered at 1310 hrs.

- (a) 01 x Carbine Machine Gun
- (b) 01 x Carbine Machine Gun Magazine (Regd. No. 15226375)
- (c) 01 x INSAS Magazine
- (d) 08 x 5.56mm Rounds
- (e) 01 x No 36 Hand Granade
- (f) 01 x 51mm Mortar Illumination Round
- (g) 01 x Local made Pumpi
- (h) 02 x Local made Grenade
- (i) 01 x Walkie Talkie
- (j) 01 x Walkie Talkie Charger

I would like to confirm that the recovered weapons and ammunitions will be handed over to your custody. In adherence to the legal and procedural requirements, we will be submitting these items to you for further investigation and necessary action.
